Key Responsibilities:

- Distribute flyers during the first week of every month
- Represent the Swaner Preserve and EcoCenter
- Pick up event flyers and/or posters at the Swaner EcoCenter prior to distribution and return any supplies to the EcoCenter after distribution

Length of Appointment: Minimum of three months

Time Commitment: Each volunteer will be given an area in which to distribute flyers: The **Kimball Junction/Quarry Village area** OR the **Prospector/Main Street area**. The distribution time for each area is approximately **one hour per month**.

Qualifications:

- Must have a valid driver's license and access to a car
- Must pass a background check if over 18
- Must be comfortable representing the Swaner Preserve and EcoCenter and talking to the public
- Must be reliable

Support: Volunteers will undergo a brief training upon arrival and receive basic instructional materials.
