Key Responsibilities:

- Greets guests and prepares them for a one-hour preserve walk/snowshoe tour
- Leads guests on a tour of the preserve
- Provides information and answers questions about the preserve

Length of Appointment: Minimum three month time commitment: Following orientation and training, tour guide volunteers may be appointed for an additional three month period where he/she will be working independently in the position.

Time Commitment:

- Time commitment, including prep and clean-up ---- Saturdays, 8:00am-10:00 am.

Qualifications:

- Must be 18 year or over
- Must pass a background check
- Must be somewhat physically fit
- Pleasant manner, patient and dependable
- Must feel comfortable leading people of all ages and abilities

Support and Training:

- Prior to training, guide candidates must read through our nature walk tour narrative
- Training includes the following:
- 1. Attend a minimum of two Saturday, 8:30 a.m., preserve tours with a Swaner staff person
- 2. Lead a Saturday, 8:30 a.m. preserve tour accompanied by a Swaner staff person
- 3. Receipt of instructional materials
